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### MINUTES: JULY 8, 2010

Additions to Agenda under old business: Twp Hall Repairs, under new Business: Coyne Propane pricing Agreement, Correspondence Mount Property

Minutes: The regular meeting minutes from June 10, 2010 were approved as presented with date change to read June 10, 2010 on Motion by Darwin, seconded by Nora. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: Dick Nellet gave updates on Strategic Planning group handling of zoning / codes, etc.

Treasurers Report: The Treasurer Shows a balance of \$97,471.35 in the general fund account and a CD worth \$60,000. Treasurers report for Winchester Subdivision Special Assessment Account \$498.32. Treasurer's report for Lackies Birch Haven #1, 2, 3, & 7 Special Assessment account \$3528.38. Motion was made by Ginger, seconded by Darwin to accept all treasurers' reports as presented. Motion carried.

Presentation of the Bills: Checks #8539 thru 8556 were presented for the General Fund account totaling \$20,647.11. No checks were presented for Winchester Sub Special Assessment account. No checks were presented for Lackies Birch Haven Special Assessment account. Motion was made by Darwin, seconded by Nora to pay all the bills as presented. Motion carried.

Assessor's Report: The Assessor reported permits issued and sales were presented. Motion by Shirley, Seconded by Vernon to accept as presented. Motion carried.

Correspondence: MTA faxes, Commissioners Minutes, Library Minutes, and Sherriff's Stats.

Old Business: Strategic planning Update: Next meeting will be late September or early October.

Green Drain Update: Letter per our request from Drain commissioner.

Review of Townships Master plan per county zoning administrator, asking for our input on our township master plan. Review and talk more next month. Ginger to talk with Marilyn Vargo for minutes and let her know we are working on it.

MDOT traffic Study read aloud. No changes, not enough volume.

Township hall repairs: Estimates on vinyl siding all and Aluminum / or vinyl soffit on all of town hall. Request 2 bids from Sherman Construction, Inc. and Young Builders. (Both are from our township)

New Business: Meeting per diems changes / discussed: all MTA trainings will be \$40. for 4 hours or less and \$80. for more than 4 hours. Any other meetings will be paid as follows:

attendance at any other pertinent meetings will only be paid with board approval in the amount \$25. per diem. Motion by Vernon, seconded by Shirley; Roll call vote all ayes 0-nays. Motion carried.

Coyne Oil Propane Price Agreement: Signed contract for \$1.89 per gallon for fixed price of 500 gallons.

Nora cannot find out any information on how penal fines are broken down or “where” they come from. Ginger and Shirley suggested calling County Clerk as she would be the one to write the check and to check with library for more information.

Public Comment: Vote for Phil Potvin campaign stopped in at the meeting.
