Treasurers Report: The Treasurer Shows a balance of \$76,259.01 in the general fund account and a CD worth \$60,000. Treasurers report for Winchester Subdivision Special Assessment Account \$1163.81. Treasurer's report for Lackies Birch Haven #1, 2, 3, & 7 Special Assessment account \$1660.67. Motion was made by Ginger, seconded by Darwin to accept all treasurers' reports as presented. Motion carried.

Presentation of the Bills: Checks #8481 thru 8448 were presented for the General Fund account totaling \$5280.64. One check #1042 presented for Winchester Sub Special Assessment account in the amount of \$90.00 for snow plowing. No checks were presented for Lackies Special Assessment account. Motion was made by Vernon, seconded by Shirley to pay all the bills as presented. Motion carried.

Assessor's Report: The Assessor reported no permits issued and 1 sale. Motion by Shirley, Seconded by Darwin to accept as presented. Motion carried.

New Business: Accept Grounds Maintenance Contract with Mrs. Wehr for 2010- 2011 mowing season. Motion by Darwin, seconded by Ginger, motion carried.

2-year cemetery pricing contract with Kraig Martin and Jack Bark Sr, to include payroll withholdings as an employee and insurance while working for our township. Motion by Ginger, seconded by Darwin. Motion carried.

Upgrade to 2010 Quicken software program for township accounting. Motion by Vernon, seconded by Nora to purchase and upgrade software. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Bob Charlie wanted to Thank Ginger and Shirley, and there help in getting him his W-2 and BOR check to him while he was in Texas.

Board Comment: Darwin wanted to than Board of Review members and Assessor as BOR went very well.
